The 5th IHS Alumni International Awards will be held between 8-13 February 2020 as part of the World Urban Forum (WUF10), Abu Dhabi, UAE



#### **SELECTION CRITERIA NOMINEES**

#### THE URBAN PROFESSIONAL AWARD

This award presents a unique opportunity to acknowledge one urban leader, manager, academic, or practitioner for his/her exemplary and outstanding contribution to the management and development of urban spaces and the promotion of more livable cities (to promote effective urban development and management).

### **NOMINEE PROFILE**

It is understood that for the Urban Professional Award, career path and trajectory will be highly evaluated. In case of the Youth Professional Award, creativity, drive, involvement and the ability to serve as a role model for other young professionals will be key aspects.

For both awards, the areas of contribution can be in any of the following themes:

- 1. **Urban social development** e.g. eradicating urban poverty, social inclusion in urban development (youth, gender, vulnerable groups) urban agriculture and promoting food security etc.
- 2. Promoting good urban governance and management.
- 3. **Environmental management and sustainability in urban areas:** biodiversity conservation in urban areas, urban park systems, climate change, green cities, flood protection, risk and disaster management, communicating, preventing and managing urban risks (bar air quality, water pollution).
- 4. **Land and housing** e.g. building effective sustainable human settlements through land *θ* tenure security, and slums/settlements upgrading; housing policy; housing right; land management and development; urban redevelopment.
- 5. **Infrastructure and service provision** e.g. water *θ* sanitation, urban waterfront enhancement, transportation strategies, development of BRT systems, metro systems, and road creation or improved of city biking infrastructure, etc.
- 6. **Local urban economic development**, macro-economics and economic geography e.g. Innovative Financing and Urban Equity.
- 7. **Technological innovation-Integrating ICT** in urban development.
- 8. **Cultural enhancement and development:** Revitalization of historic centers and arts and sports facilities for violence prevention.
- 9. Dissemination and implementation of the New Urban Agenda or the Sustainable Development Goals: Governance and partnerships, inclusive frameworks and innovation.



#### REQUIREMENTS

- The nominator should get an approval from the nominee (e.g. through an email) to share nominee's information.
- The nominator will demonstrate innovative application of the nominee's achievements with the submission of project results showing before and after scenarios in the nomination form, and provide relevant supporting documents as indicated in the nomination form.
- IHS and non IHS alumni are welcome to participate.
- Nominees cannot be related to or be work partners of the IHS International Alumni Board or IHS staff.

Kindly Note: Nominees are not allowed to nominate themselves

#### Information about previous awards:

The Urban Professional Award is meant to honour an inspiring urban professional, who has had a significant impact on their city and who, through visionary leadership, strong motivation and commitment, has managed to bring a radical change to their country's development and empower future city-changers. Previous winners include Dr. Sergio Fajardo of Colombia, Governor Kwankaso of Nigeria and Mayor Tri Rishmarini of Surabaya Indonesia.

The Youth Urban Professional Award category was introduced in 2016, to reward a young urban professional/organisation, for their exceptional work in the urban field. This award presents a unique opportunity to acknowledge one young urban professional for their exemplary and outstanding contribution to the management and development of urban spaces and the promotion of more livable cities (to promote effective urban development and management).
